FOR : PRESIDENTS/HEADS OF ALL PUBLIC HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS (HEIs) AND PRIVATE NON-STOCK HEIs AND ALL CHED REGIONAL DIRECTORS

SUBJECT : 2nd Call for Application for CHED Financial Assistance for Voluntary Accreditation

DATE : 15 August 2014

In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act No. 7722 otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", for the purpose of promoting/enhancing the quality and relevance of higher education institutions (HEIs) in the country, and pursuant to CHED Memorandum Order No. 23 s.2006 titled "*Procedures and Guidelines on Granting CHED Financial Assistance to Higher Education Institutions Undergoing Voluntary Accreditation*," all public and private non-stock HEIs are invited to apply and submit proposals for the Preliminary Survey Assistance for Accreditation (PSAA) and Institutional Development Assistance for Accreditation (IDAA).

Per CEB Resolution No. 442-2014, the new financial assistance scheme for PSAA and IDAA is as follows:


<i>Type of Grant</i>	<i>Amount of Grant</i>
CHED-PSAA	Php100,000.00 per program (maximum of three (3) programs per HEI)
CHED-IDAA	Php500,000.00 for library upgrade per HEI applicant covering one (1) or more programs
	Php500,000.00 for laboratory upgrade per HEI applicant covering one (1) or more programs

HEIs with pending applications are advised to revise their proposals to consider the increase in grant. Please be reminded that if an HEI has an unliquidated balance with the Higher Education Development Fund Secretariat (HEDFS) for a previous CHED financial assistance, its application shall not be processed.

Interested HEIs may submit their revised proposals or new applications together with supporting completed forms to the Office of Institutional Quality Assurance and Governance (OIQAG) or through the CHED Regional Offices (CHEDROs) on or before 30 September 2014. CHEDROs are requested to endorse these applications to OIQAG within one (1) week upon receipt of their applications.
