Brief background, History (antecedents), ~200 words UP connected with Filipino scholars in 12 cities across four continents as part of its strategy to internationalize and enhance its research and creative activities. In gatherings held between April and September 2015, Vice President Gisela Concepcion and Office of International Linkages (OIL) deputy director Aaron Villaraza updated the UP alumni abroad about infrastructure developments and current programs in the university. Specifically, they talked about new opportunities that were available to foreign-trained scholars such as the Balik PhD program and the Visiting Professor Program, both implemented by the Office of the Vice President for Academic Affairs and through which young and seasoned scholars can share their academic expertise with UP. Partnerships with universities abroad were also explored to strengthen the OIL-administered COOPERATE program for graduate students at early thesis or dissertation or proposal stage who wish to undertake research/creative work at a university outside the Philippines. scholars to give back to UP via financial contributions, information about UP's newly created online donation site was also disseminated.

The meetings, attended mainly by young scholars, were organized in these cities: Vienna, Berlin, Paris, London in Europe; New York City, Salt Lake City and San Francisco in the US; Brisbane and Melbourne in Australia; and Osaka, Tokyo and Sapporo in Japan. They were made possible with the help of UP alumni associations, Philippine embassies and consulates, and Filipino student organizations. Tokyo had the biggest attendance with at least 100 people, as the Philippine Consulate tied up the roadshow gathering with two big events for the Filipino community on the same day.

During the visits, there were scholars who expressed interest in applying to the Balik PhD program, although according to Dr. Villaraza, the number of applications received as a result of the roadshow could not be determined.

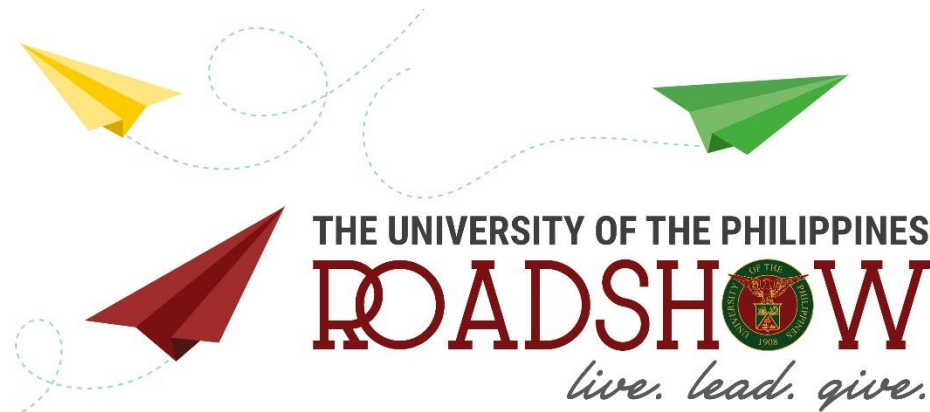

Balik PhD Recruitment Program

For foreign-trained PhDs and postdoctoral fellows to teach and conduct research in UP as faculty members; includes start-/step-up grants, relocation package and other economic incentives

Visiting Professor Program

For Filipino experts and foreign professors and researchers to spend one to two months in UP to team teach courses, mentor graduate students, and collaborate in research and creative work with UP faculty and researchers

World Experts Lecture Series

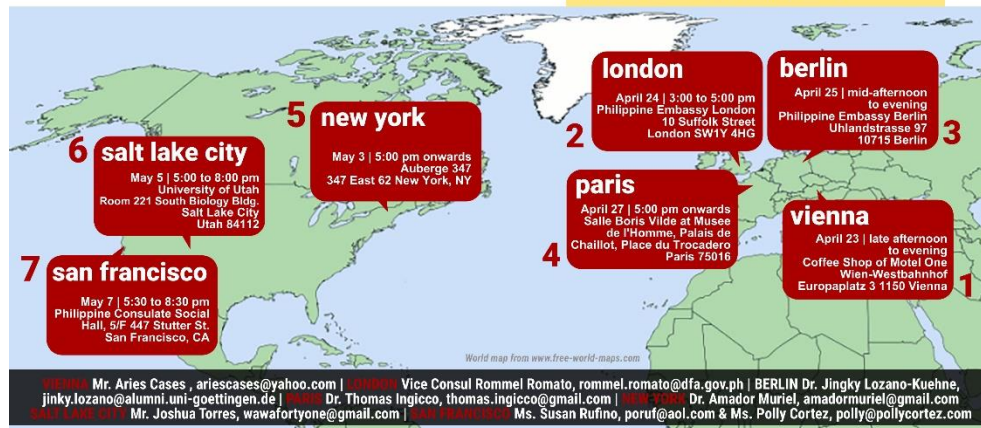
For eminent world leaders in the academe, government and industry to give special lectures in UP; covers air travel, accommodations and per diem for one week, arrangements for the convocation, publicity of the event and social functions

COOPERATE (Continuous Operational and Outcomes-based Partnership for Excellence in Research and Academic Training Enhancement)

For graduate students at early thesis or dissertation or proposal stage, needing to undertake research/creative work at a foreign university; for a UP research adviser to undertake a short-term visit to a foreign potential research/creative work co-adviser/group; for continuing research/creative work collaboration and publication/productivity

MOVE UP (University of the Philippines Mobility for Vigor and Excellence)

For junior or senior undergraduate students with high scholastic average, with full or partial support (based on the socialized tuition system) for one semester enrolment in a foreign university as exchange student
