As part of the partnership between the Commission on Higher Education (CHED) and the Institut d'Etudes Politiques de Paris (Sciences Po), we are pleased to announce the call for applications for the "CHED-Sciences Po Scholarship Program for September 2018 Intake".

This is part of our continued effort during the K to 12 Transition to provide and expand opportunities for qualified teaching and non-teaching personnel to gain expertise and training in emerging disciplines that are yet in incipient stages of development locally, as well as by investing in potential leaders of such sectors, both to enrich academic instruction and to greatly contribute to the practice of such fields or professions.

The CHED-Sciences Po Scholarship Program is an international scholarship opportunity offered for higher education teaching and non-teaching personnel who wish to pursue graduate degree in Sciences Po: one of the leading international research university for social sciences and humanities based in France, educating French and international decision-makers since 1872.

# CHED-SCIENCES PO SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM for September 2018 Intake

## II. Eligibility Criteria for Master's and PhD Scholarships

The scholarships herein described are intended for Filipino faculty and staff relative to CHED K to 12 Transition Program. The scholarship is provided to the degree seeking candidates only, and no dependents will be supported.

#### Each applicant must:

- 1. Be a Filipino citizen;
- 2. Not be more than 42 years old for applicants to master's degree programs, not mroe than 40 years old for applicants to PhD degree programs;
- Hold at least a bachelor's degree (for applicants to master's degree programs) or a master's degree (for applicants to PhD degree programs) relevant to the graduate degree being sought;
- 4. Have a record of academic excellence, and show evidence of outstanding potential for professional advancement in teaching and/or administration;
- 5. Be in good health and of good moral character;
- Have no pending criminal charges, and must not have been convicted for violation of any Philippine Law;
- Be conversant in English (TOEFL and/or IELTS results are required by Sciences Po); and
- 8. Be committed to return to their home institution after completion of the degree
