MERIT PROMOTIONS (FMP) FOR YOUR REFERENCE

We are providing, for your reference, the attached comparative tables of assessment of achievements for each disciplinal cluster based on the deliberations of the Academic Affairs Committee (AAC), acting as the System Academic Personnel and Fellowship Committee (APFC), on the FMP applications for the associate professor and professor ranks. These tables may help you explain the result of the AAC's comparative evaluation at the System level of the achievements of the faculty who did not get the steps recommended by their Constituent University (CU) within the academic rank. Please note that while the AAC focused on accomplishments in research and teaching (following the expectations of the academic rank as stipulated in the Guidelines), the faculty's public service and extension work figured for those whose achievements were evaluated to fall between steps. You may provide the faculty concerned with the comparative table for their cluster as an overview of the accomplishments given the maximum 3-step, 2-step, and 1- step promotion across different academic clusters in the FMP deliberations, as needed.

Should the faculty opt to withdraw their application for the 2022 FMP, please request them to formally submit their request to withdraw to the Office of the Vice-Chancellor for Academic Affairs (OVCAA) on or before **Wednesday**, **15 February 2023**. The VCAAs are requested to submit a consolidated list of withdrawals of faculty FMP applications by **Monday**, **20 February 2023**.

By **TUESDAY**, **31** January **2023**, we shall be transmitting individual letters to faculty members who were neither promoted nor unable to cross ranks as decided upon by the System Disciplinal Cluster Committee, to whom the AAC submits the list of faculty members recommended to cross ranks. Our letter will also give the same **15 February 2023** deadline for submitting to the OVCAA of their CU, faculty letters withdrawing their application for the 2022 FMP.
